RESOLUTION NO. 37

Letter of the Division Superint and ent of Schools for Leyte, dated at Tacloban City on March 14, 1,59, quoted verbatin nereunder, reads:

Gentlemen:

On the basis of the pledge of Hon. Dominador M. Tan that he would take all steps necessary to keep the Ormoc City High School on a permanent basis by providing national fund for the construction of its building and your promise to secure an 8-hectare school te before June 6, 1959, the undersigned recommended to the Director of Public Schools on June 13, 1958, the continuance of the operation of the said high school. May I be favored with information as to the progress being made in regard to the acquisition of an 8hectare school site and the appropriation for the building to be constructed on the site. Without justifiable basis, it would be officult for this Office to make another recommendation for the continuance of the operation of the Ormoc City High School during the School Year 1959-1960, - it appearing that the school was granted authority to continue operating only for the present school year in a telegram received by this Office dated June 13, 1958.

Much against my will, I deeply regret to inform you that because of definite instructions from the Director of Public Schools embodied in General Letter No. 71, dated February 28, 1958, to recommend the closure of high schools that do not have sites and buildings, the Ormoc City High School will not be permitted by this Office to open on June 6, 1959, unless it can show evidences that it has met the site-and-building requirement.

The Teacher-In-Charge of the school and, thru him, all members of the faculty have been informed of the imminent closing of the high school.

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved to rewind Congressman
Dominador M. Tan of his promise of the acquisition of the shectare
Ormoc City High School site and its building when he was commencement speaker of said school on March 28, 1958, respectfully inviting
his attention in this connection, to the above quoted letter of the
Division Superintendence of Schools;

"RESOLVED FURTHER, to request Congressian Dominador M. Tan, to make representations with the Department of Education for the continuance of the operation of the Ormoc City High School in the meantime that the city is still looking for an appropriate site for said school;

"MESOLVE FINALLY, to furnish copies of this resolution each to Congressman Cominator M. Tan, HR, Manila; the Division Superintendent of Schools, Tacloban City; the Teacher-in-Charge, OCHS, Comoc City; the City Treasurer, Ormoc City; and the City Auditor, Ormoc City.

"CAMRIED, Unanimously."
