"RESULVED, as it is hereby resolved, to appropriate the sum of 1200.00 from out of the salary savings of the Police Department, to be made available for the payment of burial expenses of the late Pat. Guillermo Magno, member of the Ormoc City Police Department who died in line of duty on January 13, 1959;

"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this resolution each to the City Treasurer, the City Auditor and the Chief of Police, all of Ormoc City.
