RESOLUTION NO. 46

"WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 699 of the Rev. Adm. Code as amended by Rep. Act 1232, payment of reasonable burial expenses is allowed to a person in the service of the national, provincial, city or municipal government if such person is killed or dies of injuries received or sickness contracted in line of duty; and

"WHEREAS, Pat. Guillermo Magno, of the Ormoc City Police Department, was killed in line of duty, and, therefore, payment of reasonable burial expenses is allowable under the provisions of the aforesaid law;


"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Du, seconded by Councilor Ocubillo;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to appropriate the sum of P200.00 from out of the salary savings of the Police Department, to be made available for the payment of burial expenses of the late Pat. Guillermo Magno, member of the Ormoc City Police Department who died in line of duty on January 13, 1959;


"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this resolution each to the City Treasurer, the City Auditor and the Chief of Police, all of Ormoc City.

"CARRIED, Unanimously."


