RESOLUTION NO. 70

"WHEREAS, said Lot No. 2255 is owned by the National Government and that the City Government of Ormoc would like to acquire the same in order to solve the squatters problem of this City;

"WHEREAS, these actual occupants of Lot No. 2255 have improvements thereon of long standing and to eject them would only broaden our squatters problem;


"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Teotimo P. Ocubillo, seconded by Vice-Mayor Mejia and all the Councilors present; Larrazabal, Samson, Penserga, Parrilla, Gutierrez, and Du;


"RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, to request the Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources, thru the Bureau of Lands, to give Lot No. 2255 of the Ormoc Cadastre to the City Government of Ormoc in order to solve the squatters problem of the City.


"RESOLVED, FINALLY, to furnish copy of this resolution each the Honorable Secretary of Agriculture and Natrual Resources and the Bureau of Lands, both of Manila, and the Honorable City Mayor, the City Treasurer, the City Auditor and the City Engineer, all of Ormoc City.
