RESOLUTION NO. 77

"WHEREAS, the residents of Milagro have furnished a copy of their petition addressed to Congressman Dominador M. Tan of the 2nd District of Leyte to this Board, petitioning the said Congressman Tan to "implore for aid..." to rehabilitate their dilapidating school building; and

"WHEREAS, according to the same petition the barrio people of Milagro can not by their own means, repair their school building with their meager income of one peso per day working in the nearby sugar and coffee plantation;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor M. S. Du, seconded by Councilor Ocubillo;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to favorably indorse the said petition to Congressman Dominador M. Tan, House of Representatives, Manila, and to urge said Congressman Tan to immediately take action on the petition;


"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish a copy of this resolution each to the Secretary of Labor, Manila, inviting attention to the last paragraph of the preamble of the herein attached petition; and the Petitioners, thru the Barrio Lieutenant of Dolores, Ormoc City.
