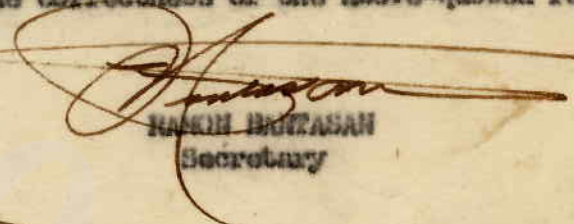
"AND, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councillor Du, seconded by Councillor Penserger;

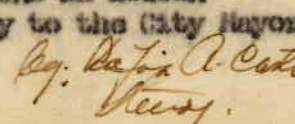
