RESOLUTION NO. 93

"WHEREAS, in view of the death of the late Rev. Fr. Federico Copuaco who during his lifetime had served the best interests of the people of Ormoc City in general, this Board as decided to purchase two wreaths from the appropriations for Discretionary Fund of the City Mayor, the same to be delivered to the bereaved family of the late Rev. Fr. Copuaco, with appropriate inscriptions stating among other things that one is from the Municipal Board and the other from the City Officials of Ormoc City;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Parrilla, seconded by Councilor Omega;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to authorize the Honorable City Mayor, Ormoc City, to cause to be purchased, two wreaths to be delivered to the bereaved family of the late Rev. Fr. Federico Copuaco, in which there shall be a sign stating among other things, that one is from the Municipal Board and the other from the City Officials of Ormoc City, the funds to be taken from the Discretionary Fund of the City Mayor;


"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this resolution each to the City Treasurer and the City Auditor, both of Ormoc City.

"CARRIED, Unanimously."


