RESOLUTION NO. 94

"WHEREAS, this Body in its regular session held on October 11, 1957, passed Resolution No. 194, extending the period of effectivity of Ordinance No. IX (An Ordinance establishing and fixing the location of industrial zones within the City of Ormoc and requiring industrial establishments in the city to transfer their establishments to the industrial zone within the period of two years, with provision for penalty), series of 1956, to a period of four years from July 5, 1958, the date of expiry of the original period of two years prescribed in said ordinance;

"WHEREAS, the real intention of the Board in passing the aforementioned resolution is to ~~12/10~~ suspend the effectivity of the ordinance as regards to the transferring only of those stationary engines and other industrial establishments already established and actually and legally operating as of October 11, 1957, but the other purpose of the ordinance - the establishing and fixing the location of industrial zones within the City of Ormoc - should continue to be in force and effect as of the day the said Ordinance No. IX took effect;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Gutierrez, seconded by Councilor Du;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to amend Resolution No. 194, series of 1957, of this Board, such that the extension of the period of effectivity of Ordinance No. IX, series of 1956 to a period of four years from July 5, 1958, refer only to the ~~the~~ transferring of the industrial establishments affected by said ordinance, such as lumber mills, corn and rice mills, and other engines of 6 horse power or more, already established and legally and actually operating as of October 11, 1957, but the other purpose of the said ordinance - the establishing and fixing the location of industrial zones within the City of Ormoc - should continue to be in full force and effect as of the day the said Ordinance No. IX took effect;
