RESOLUTION NO. 98

"WHEREAS, by resolution enacted of even date, this Board has adopted the athletic team of the Police Department as the official team representing Ormoc City in any athletic competition;

"Whereas, the Assistant Chief of Police who is now the team's coach, has made representations with this Board asking that the team be provided with uniforms and athletic equipments for their daily practice; and

"WHEREAS, in order that the team can practice and train daily, this Body deems it proper to provide them with the necessary athletic equipment as well as the uniform which all in all is estimated to cost about P300;


"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Ocubillo, seconded by Councilor Penserga;

"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this resolution each to the City Treasurer, the City Auditor and the Chief of Police, all of Ormoc City.
