RESOLUTION NO. 103

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to revert from the balance of the appropriation for the purchase of the two police jeeps, the sum of ₱300.00 to the Discretionary Fund of the City Mayor;


"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this resolution each to the City Treasurer, the City Auditor and the Chief of Police, all of Ormoc City.

"CARRIED, Unanimously."


