Quexon; in active law practice since 1921 in the Visayas and Mindanao and Attely in Manila and the neighboring provinces; and a Mana Cum Laide in the College of Law, University of Sto. Tomas; and

WIFE VAR, Atty Victorino N. Salazar, has all the qualifications necessary to qualify him for the position of Judge of Court of First Instance;

"NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Parrilla, seconded by Councilor Omega;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to earnestly request His Excellency, President Carlos P. Garcia, to consider the name of Atty. Victorino N. Salazar, for appointment as judge of the Court of First Instance;

"RETOLVED FINALLY, to forward this resolution to His Excellency, President Carlos P. Gartia; and copies furnished each to the Secretary of Justice, the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and Congressman Dominador M. Tan, all of Manila.
