RESOLUTION NO. 15

"WHEREAS, it is of general knowledge that there are positions of judges of Courts of First Instance which may be left vacant due to incumbent judges who are to retire soon by operation of law;

"WHEREAS, in the appointment of judges only those who are most qualified will be given preference considering the qualifications of each;

"WHEREAS, Atty. Victorino N. Salazar, had been a duly elected delegate to the Constitutional Convention for the 3rd Congressional District of Leyte; a District Attorney for Mindanao and Sulu from 1940 to 1942, having been appointed as such by the late President Manuel L. Quezon; in active law practice since 1921 in the Visayas and Mindanao and lately in Manila and the neighboring provinces; and a Magna Cum Laude in the College of Law, University of Sto. Tomas; and

"WHEREAS, Atty. Victorino N. Salazar, has all the qualifications necessary to qualify him for the position of Judge of Court of First Instance;


"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Parrilla, seconded by Councilor Omega;






