RESOLUTION NO. 155

"WHEREAS, there are several employees now employed in the different offices of the city government who are not civil service eligibles but who have met the requirements set forth in Republic Act 2260 to qualify them to take qualifying examinations; and

"WHEREAS, in order to give these employees a chance to show their fitness in the service this body deems it most advantageous to make the place of examination easily accessible to them, i.e., to hold an examination in Ormoc City;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to request the Commissioner of Civil Service, Manila to hold a qualifying civil service examination in Ormoc City this year, in order to give a chance to the employees to qualify;


"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this resolution each to the Commissioner of Civil Service, Manila; Congressman Dominador M. Tan, House of Representatives, Manila; and the City Treasurer, Ormoc City.

"CARRIED, Unanimously."




