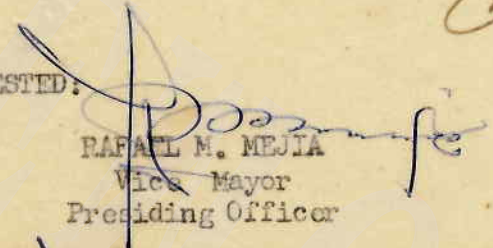
RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this resolution each to the City Treasurer, the City Auditor and the Chief of Police, all of Ormoc City.

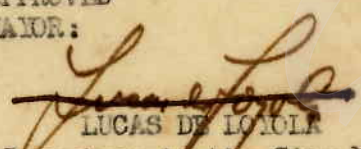
