SEPTEMBER 29, 1959

RESOLUTION NO. 179

"WHEREAS, the Municipal Judge, this City, in a letter to this Board dated August 28, 1959 quoted certain provisions of the Judiciary Act of 1948 as amended by Republic Act No. 2613 which took effect on August 1, 1959, to the effect that Municipal Courts shall have like jurisdiction as the Court of First Instance to try parties charged with an offense committed within the province in which the penalty provided by law does not exceed prison correctional or imprisonment for not more than six years or fine not exceeding three thousand pesos or both;

"WHEREAS, the afore-mentioned Act provides further, that "Proceedings had shall be recorded and decisions therein shall be appealable direct to the Court of Appeals or the Supreme Court, as the case may be", in which case it becomes necessary that the Municipal Court must be provided with a Stenographer;

"WHEREAS, in view of the hardships of the city's finances at this part of the year, it would be practically impossible to create the position of Stenographer as requested by the Municipal Judge in his aforesaid letter;

"WHEREAS, this Board's Senior Clerk in the person of Mr. Ireneo B. Leal, is also a stenographer;

"WHEREAS, by designating Mr. Leal as Stenographer to the Municipal Court and increasing his pay by ₱30.00 per month, is much more economical than creating a new position of Stenographer which is impractical and unwise at this time; and

"WHEREAS, in view of the urgency of the request of the Municipal Judge, this Body is bent on designating Mr. Leal as Stenographer to the Municipal Court effective October 1, 1959, although he remains Senior Clerk of this Board;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Parrilla, seconded by Councilor Gutierrez;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to designate Mr. Ireneo B. Leal, Senior Clerk of this Board, as Stenographer to the Municipal Court effective October 1, 1959;

"RESOLVED FURTHER, that while Mr. Leal is designated Stenographer to the Municipal Court, he still remains to be the Senior Clerk of the Municipal Board with increased salary from his present rate of ₱1,680

per annum to ₱2,040.00 per annum, the new rate to take effect October 1, 1959;

"RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that effective October 1, 1959, the item of the Senior Clerk in the Office of the Municipal Board as appearing in the current annual budget of the city, should be amended to read as follows:


One : Senior Clerk (from ₱1,680) ₱2,040.00;

"RESOLVED STILL FURTHERMORE, that the amount of ₱270.00 be re-verted from out of the salary savings of the position of Agricultural Adviser and Fertilizer in-Charge in the Office of the City Mayor which is incorporated in the current annual budget but remains unfilled un-til date, to cover the deficiency of the appropriation for the above-mentioned position of Senior Clerk up to June 30, 1960, which is here-by increased from ₱1,680 to ₱2,040 per annum effective October 1, 1959;

"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this resolution each to the Honorable City Mayor, the City Treasurer, the City Auditor and the Municipal Judge, all of Ormoc City.

"CARRIED, Unanimously."
