RESOLUTION NO. 7

A RESOLUTION URGENTLY REQUESTING HIS EXCELLENCY, THE
PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES, THROUGH THE HONORABLE
SECRETARY OF FINANCE, TO EXEMPT FROM MEMORANDUM
CIRCULAR NO. 518, SERIES OF 1971, THE PURCHASE OF
NECESSARY EQUIPMENT AND FURNISHINGS FOR THE
NEW CITY HALL OF ORMOC CITY

"WHEREAS, the City Government would like now to avail
itself of the provision of the sum of P35,000.00 in the
1972-1973 Ormoc City Budget for the purchase of equipment
and furnishings necessary for the new City Hall the cons-
truction of which is nearing completion;

"WHEREAS, in view of Memorandum Circular No. 593 dated
August 8, 1972, of the Office of the President, reiterating
Memorandum Circular No. 518, series of 1971, suspending,
among other things, the purchase of all government offices
of furniture and equipment, except those deemed necessary
for relief and rehabilitation, the Office of the City Au-
ditor in a communication dated January 4, 1973, has advis-
ed that they will not be in a position to favorably recom-
mend the projected purchases, notwithstanding the appropri-
ation of P35,000.00 in the current fiscal year's city bud-
get;

"WHEREAS, aware of the urgency of the purchase, the
Office of the City Auditor has, on the other hand, advised
this august Body that a request be made with the Office of
the President, through the Department of Finance, for the
exemption of the contemplated purchase above mentioned in
the exigency of public service;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Samson, se-
conded by Councilor Porcadilla;


"RESOLVED, to urgently request His Excellency, the
President of the Philippines, through the Honorable Sec-
retary of Finance, to exempt from Memorandum Circular No.
518, series of 1971, the purchase of necessary equipment
and furnishings for the new City Hall of Ormoc City;


