RESOLUTION NO. 7 A RESOLUTION URGENTLY REQUESTING HIS CELLING, THE PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES, THROUGH THE HONORABLE SECRETARY OF FINANCE, TO EXAMPT FROM ADVORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 518, SERIES CO 1971, THE PURCHASE OF NECESSARY EQUIPMENT AND FURNISHINGS FOR THE NEW CITY HALL OF ORMOG CITY

"WHEREAS, the City Covernment would like now to avail itself of the provision of the sum of \$25,000.00 in the 1972-1973 Ormoc City Budget for the purchase of equipment and furnishings necessary for the new City Hall the construction of which is nearing completion;

August 8, 1974, of the Office of the President, reiterating Memorandum Circular No. 518, series of 1971, suspending, among other thinks, the purchase of all government offices among otter things, the purchase of all government offices of furniture and equipment, except those deemed necessary for relief and rehabilitation, the Office of the City Auditor in a communication dated January 4, 1973, has advised that they will not be in a position to favorably recomhend the projected purchases, notwithstanding the appropri-ation of \$35,000.00 in the current fiscal year's city budget;

"WHEREAS, aware of the urgency of the purchase, the Office of the City Auditor has, on the other hand, advised this august Body that a request be made with the Office of the President, through the Department of Finance, for the exemption of the contemplated purchase above mentioned in the exigency of public service;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Samson, seconded by Councilor Porcadilla;

"RESOLVED, to urgently request His Excellency, the President of the Philippines, through the Honorable Secretary of Finance, to exempt from Memorandum Circular No. 518, series of 1971, the purchase of necessary equipment and furnishings for the new City Hall of Ormoc City;

"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution each to His Excellency, the President of the Philippines, and the Honorable Executive Secretary, both in Malacañang, the Honorable Secretary of Finance, all in Manila; the Honorable City Mayor, the City Treasurer and the City Auditor, all of Ormoc City;

"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."
