RESOLUTION NO. 24

A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN CITY ROADS AS NATIONAL
ROADS, TO BECOME INTEGRAL PART OF THE NATIONAL
SECONDARY ROAD SYSTEM, PURSUANT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER
NO. 113, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE CITY ENGINEER

"WHEREAS, the City Engineer in his communication dated February 5, 1973, to hasten the improvement, development and progress of Ormoc City, in particular, and of Leyte Province, in general, has requested this august Body to declare the following Ormoc City roads as national roads, to become integral parts of our national secondary road system, pursuant to the general provisions of Executive Order No. 113, to wit:

1. Ormoc-Merida Road, at Kms. 111.623-121.900, 10.277 kilometers long, connecting the newly declared Puertobello-Merida-Isabel-Palompon National Road ending at Km. 121.900 and the existing Libertad-Cogon Combado National Road ending at Km. 111.623, to form a single continuous route;
2. Simangan-Dolores-Milagro Tungonan Road, at Kms. 104.566-119.700, 15.134 kilometers long, leading to and ending at Tungonan Hot Springs National Park and the NPC Geothermal Development project; and connecting junctions of existing national roads;
3. Ormoc-Donghol-Lake Danao Road, at Kms. 108.674-1116.255, 7.581 kilometers long, leading to and ending at Lake Danao National Park, and bridging the gap that separates two existing national roads; and 7.5 kilometers circumferential road along the perimeter of the lake - a total of 15.081 kilometers; and
4. Catalino Hermosilla Drive-San Pablo-Aguadulce Road, at Kms. 108.774-109.850, 1.076 kilometers long, which is an access road connecting a main trunkline to a junction of a national road;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Aviles, seconded jointly by Councilors Mendola and Porcadilla;

"RESOLVED, to declare the following Ormoc City roads as National Roads, to become integral parts of our National Secondary Road System, totalling 41.568 kilometers, pursuant to Executive Order No. 113, as recommended by the City Engineer, to wit:
