**RESOLUTION NO. 1027**

A RESOLUTION REITERATING OUR REQUEST EMBODIED IN RESOLUTION NO. 991 FOR THE HONORABLE MINISTER OF PUBLIC HIGHWAYS, NOW MINISTER OF INFRASTRUCTURES, FOR AN AUTHORITY TO UNDERTAKE THE SANTO NIÑO-BILIBOY-DONGHOL-SUMANGA-BANTIGUE-IPIL DIVERSION ROAD CONSTRUCTION IN ORMOC CITY BY ADMINISTRATION


"WHEREAS, this august Body will recall having passed Resolution No. 991 on June 9, 1981, respectfully requesting the Honorable Minister of Public Highways, now Minister of Infrastructures, through the Regional Director, for an authority to undertake the Santo Niño-Biliboy-Donghol-Sumanga-Ipil Diversion Road by administration in view of Batas Pambansa Blg. 80 providing, among other things, an appropriation of Four Hundred Nine Thousand Pesos (P409,000.00) for the construction of the said diversion road;

"WHEREAS, we would like to reiterate our request embodied in the said resolution believing as we do that if this project will be undertaken by administration it could immediately be started inasmuch as publication of invitation to bid, preparation and approval of contract papers, and other procedures could be dispensed with, thus enabling the Office of the City Engineer to take advantage of the favorable weather condition now prevailing coupled with the off-milling season of the sugar central;

"WHEREAS, this Body also believes that the amount of the appropriation involved in this particular project is not attractive neither is it inviting to contractors and, therefore, if the said project will be undertaken by administration, labor intensive method, where applicable, will be used, thereby greatly relieving unemployment in the locality; and

WHEREAS, bulldozers, graders and other heavy equipment are readily available in the Office of the City Engineer handled by trained technical and skilled personnel who have had successfully undertaken similar projects with greater efficiency and, giving them the opportunity to undertake this particular project would mean a very much lower cost of construction considering that the contractor's profit will ultimately be eliminated;

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"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Santiago, seconded unanimously by all the other Mga Kagawad present; be it

"RESOLVED, to reiterate our request embodied in Resolution No. 991 dated June 9, 1981, and do, as this Body hereby does, respectfully request the Honorable Minister of Infrastructures for an authority to undertake the Santo Niño-Biliboy-Donghol-Sumanga-Bantigue-Ipil Diversion Road Construction in Ormoc City by administration; and be it

"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution each to Hon. Jesus Hipolito, Minister of Infrastructures, Port Area, Metro Manila; the Regional Director, Ministry of Infrastructures, Paoing, Palo, Leyte; and the City Engineer, Ormoc City;

"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."
