RESOLUTION NO. 1124

A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE NATIONAL ELECTRIFICATION
ADMINISTRATION AND THE NATIONAL POWER CORPORATION TO ISOLATE
OR SEGREGATE ORMOG CITY FROM ANY OTHER CITY AND MUNICIPALITIES
OUT OF THE ELECTRIC POWER BARGE SERVICES UNDER THE NPC
INTEGRATION PROGRAM

"WHEREAS, this august Body had learned that very soon the
electric power barge will be installed in Isabel, Leyte, and
that its electric services will be integrated with the Tugonon
geothermal electric power;

"WHEREAS, this Body is fully aware that consequent to the
said integration a possible increase in electric costs will cer-
tainly be imposed by LEYECO V;

"WHEREAS, the people of Ormoc have long been clamoring for
lower costs of electric consumption considering that Ormoc is
just right within the vicinity of or nearest the source of geo-
thermal power at its very own barangay of Tugonon, as a matter
of fact, as of this month of March the cost of electric consump-
tion has already been lowered to sixty-five centavos (P0.65) per
kilowatthour and, therefore, as a result of such integration, it
would just be an irony of fate that we Ormocanons who are just
right at the source of power would be paying higher electric
costs in the same manner as people would pay even those who are
far from the source of electric power;

"WHEREAS, it is for this reason that this august Body be-
lieves that in order for the people of Ormoc to enjoy a lower
cost of electric consumption as a blessing brought forth because
of its being near the source of geothermal power in Tugonon, this
city be segregated from other municipalities or places that would
be using the electric power barge;

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"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Torrevillas, seconded by Kagawad Santiago; be it

"RESOLVED, to earnestly request the National Electrification Administration and the National Power Corporation to isolate or segregate Ormoc City from any other city and municipalities out of the electric power barge services under the integration program of the National Power Corporation; and be it

"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution each to the Honorable First Lady and Human Settlements Minister, Madam Imelda Romualdez-Marcos, Office of the President, Malacañang, Col. Pedro Dumol, Administrator, National Electrification Administration, 10050 Quezon Avenue, Q.C., Mr. Gabriel Echon, President, National Power Corporation, Quezon Ave. cor. BIR Road, Diliman, Q.C., all in Metro Manila; the General Manager and the President, Board of Directors, both of LEYECO V, the Project Engineers of both the National Electrification Administration and the National Power Corporation, all in the City of Ormoc;
