

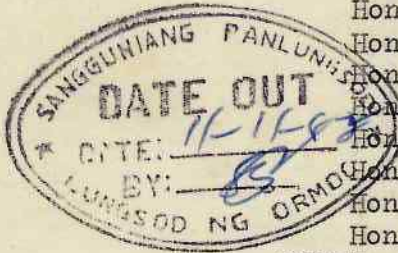

RESOLUTION NO. 1263

A RESOLUTION URGENTLY REQUESTING THE PHILIPPINE LONG DISTANCE
TELEPHONE CO., INC., TO GIVE PRIORITY TO INCREASE AND IMPROVE
THE PRESENT THREE-CHANNEL CAPACITY OF THE ORMOG CITY
TELEPHONE COMPANY TO TEN (10) DIRECT-DIALING
CHANNELS TO GIVE MAXIMUM SERVICE TO THE CALLING PUBLIC

"WHEREAS, quite a number of public officials and private individuals has turned to the City Administration for assistance to make representations with the Ormoc City Telephone Company for improvement of its long distance service inasmuch as more often than not callers have to wait from 30 minutes to one hour for the earliest contact such that, sometimes, they have to dispense with the calls ultimately to their own prejudice;

"WHEREAS, upon verification with the management of the Ormoc City Telephone Company this august Body had gathered that for the present they really cannot cope up with the heavy traffic of callers as they are operating only on a three-channel capacity and all they need is the increase and improvement of this capacity to ten (10) direct-dialing channels in order that they can render maximum service to the public;

"WHEREAS, telephone communication is a vital factor in business, commerce and industry, especially in Ormoc City where business establishments, commercial centers and industrial plants are in constant communication with domestic and foreign partners in their enterprises not only in the U.S.A. but also in Japan, Australia, New Zealand, Spain and other European countries, not to mention the Middle East;

"WHEREAS, there is a growing demand for the expansion of the long distance service of the Ormoc City Telephone Company to accommodate the ever-increasing long distance calls, more so now, considering that our very own Governor of Leyte, the Honorable Benjamin Romualdez, has been inviting the private sector to look to Leyte for their next investment even as he transforms the province into a center of activities with his target for a viable economy based on large-scale productions and the establishment of more industries supported by adequate overhead facilities and relevant social technologies while the different plants and their satellite industries will become the core of the first Leyte Industrial Estate;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Santiago, seconded unanimously by all the other Mga Kagawad; be it

"RESOLVED, to urgently request the Philippine Long Distance Telephone Co., Inc., to give priority to increase and improve the present three-channel capacity of the Ormoc City Telephone Company to ten (10) Direct-Dialing Channels to give maximum service to the calling public; and be it

"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution each to Mr. Ramon Cojuangco, President, Philippine Long Distance Co., Inc., Makati, Metro Manila; Hon. Benjamin Romualdez, Governor of Leyte, Tacloban City; and Mr. Narciso C. Alfaro, President, and Mr. Sony Socrates, General Manager, both of the Ormoc City Telephone Company, this city;

"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."
