RESOLUTION NO. 1283

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE ORMOC TENNIS CLUB TO MANAGE, OPERATE  
AND MAINTAIN THE CITY TENNIS COURTS FOR A PERIOD OF FOUR YEARS,  
SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS SET BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD

"WHEREAS, the President and Director of the Ormoc Tennis Club  
in his communication of December 6, 1982, has requested this august  
Body, through the Honorable Vice-Mayor and Presiding Officer, that  
the Club be granted an extension of five years to manage, operate  
and maintain the city tennis courts, subject to the conditions that  
this Body may impose;

"WHEREAS, the request of the President and Director of the Or-  
moc Tennis Club may be granted but, considering, however, that the  
term of this august Body will be terminated four years from now so  
that, taking the part of prudence, we might as well grant them an  
extension of only four years subject to conditions set forth by the  
Honorable Body such extension to take effect on January 1, 1983;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Samson, seconded jointly  
by Mga Kagawad Mendola and Torrevillas; be it

"RESOLVED, to grant extension to the Ormoc Tennis Club and do,  
as this Body hereby does, authorize the said Club to manage, operate  
and maintain the city tennis courts for a period of four years effec-  
tive January 1, 1983, subject, however, to the following conditions:

1. The Club shall be in charge of the care and maintenance of the tennis courts.
2. The assessment of the maintenance and upkeep of the courts shall be made by the Committee on Sports at least two times a year and such assessment shall be reported to the Sangguniang Panlungsod.
3. The Club is authorized to schedule the time of use of the courts even for non-members.
4. The Club is required to reserve one cement court at all times for the use of the public: Provided, However, that this reserved court can be used by Club members when not in use by the public and during tournament games.
5. The Club is authorized to schedule the time of play or use of the reserved court for the public on a first-come-first-served basis to avoid monopoly of the use of the said court.
6. The Club shall see to it that amateur rules shall be observed and the spirit of sportsmanship shall be upheld at all times.

7. If possible, the Club shall require tennis attire but, strictly, only tennis or rubber shoes shall be permitted in playing over the courts.

8. For the use of the lights, the Club has the right to impose a fee proportionate to the amount of power consumed, including depreciation charges.

9. The Club shall conduct seminars and tennis clinics for young tennis enthusiasts.

10. If possible, the Club shall conduct or hold a yearly tennis tournament for players 18 years of age and below. In such tournament games the Club is authorized to charge a fee to cover expenses on balls and other incidental expenses pertinent to the tournament.

11. No fee shall be collected from the general public for the use of the reserved court except when the lights are used in which case they shall be charged accordingly.

12. The Club is authorized to solicit donations for prizes for tournament games.

13. The courts shall be cleared of trees and, in their stead, roofed shades shall be constructed by the Club. Trees should be planted outside the fence only.

14. Mowing of the grass lawn shall be done more frequently.

15. The Club shall duly consider the construction of cement benches for spectators outside.

16. The Sangguniang Panlungsod reserves the right to modify, promulgate rules, introduce modification on conditions and revoke the authority given to the Club as the occasion may demand but only after due consultation with the Club.

"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution to the President and Director, Ormoc Tennis Club, this city;

"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."
