RESOLUTION NO. 1398

A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE KBL REGIONAL DIRECTORATE,
THROUGH THE CHAIRMAN, THE HONORABLE AMBASSADOR AND LETYEE
GOVERNOR BENJAMIN T. ROMUALDEZ, TO KINDLY CONSIDER
THE INCLUSION OF AT LEAST ONE ORMOCANON IN THE
KBL SLATE OF CANDIDATES FOR ASSEMBLYMEN OF
REGION VIII IN THE ELECTIONS OF 1984

"WHEREAS, since 1972 Ormoc City has never had any of its resi-
dents occupying a national position capable of attending to the
needs of the city at the national level specially so now that the
city population has already soared to more than one hundred ten thou-
sand (110,000);

"WHEREAS, with the operations in high gear of the Tugonon
Geothermal Power plant of the National Power Corporation and the
copper smelter plant of the Philippine Associated Smelting and
Refining (PASAR) Corporation in stride with the expected sprout-
ing of satellite factories around the immediate vicinity of the
industrial state of Isabel, Leyte, while on-going multifarious
projects are being prosecuted in the poblacion and barangays or
suburbs of Ormoc City, the latter has virtually become a busi-
ness metropolis and a hub and beehive of commercial activities
for commuters from Manila, Cebu and, practically, all over the
archipelago;

"WHEREAS, for the sake of equity this august Body would like
to appeal to the KBL Regional Directorate in the sense that Ormoc
City has no representation at all in the Datasang Pambansa;

"WHEREAS, present projections are glaringly indicative that
in a not-too-distant future Ormoc population will be more tremen-
dously increasing such that the Ormocanons, in justice and fair-
ness, ought to have a representation even by just one berth in
the KBL slate of candidates for assemblymen of Region VIII;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on joint motion of Mga Kagawad Besabella and
Larrazabal, seconded unanimously by all the other Mga Kagawad pre-
sent; be it


