RESOLUTION NO. 1409

A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE FIRST LADY AND MINISTER OF HUMAN SETTLEMENTS, THROUGH THE HONORABLE MINISTER OF ENERGY, THE PRESIDENT OF THE NATIONAL POWER CORPORATION, AND THE NATIONAL ELECTRIFICATION ADMINISTRATOR, TO ALLOW ORMOC CITY TO ORGANIZE ITS OWN ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE SEPARATE FROM THE LEYTE V ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE (LEYECO V), INC.

"WHEREAS, the people are clamoring for the separation of Ormoc City from the Leyte V Electric Cooperative (LEYECO V), Inc., and, subsequently, organize its own electric cooperative in view of the following reasons:

- (1) Ormoc is an ever-growing city with a population now of over one hundred thousand (110,000) with which we believe that the facilities of LEYECO V, both in its technical and administrative aspects, cannot cope up with the demands for good services considering the wide or vast area that LEYECO V covers;
- (2) The LEYECO V management is persistently indifferent to the needs of the Ormocanons coupled with its inefficiency in providing electricity for the rural areas of Ormoc;

"WHEREAS, once allowed to form its own electric cooperative, Ormoc City will directly fall under the Ministry of Human Settlements through the National Power Corporation with the overall su-pervision of the National Electrification Administration;

"WHEREAS, the separation of Ormoc City from LEYECO V will be in one way or another advantageous to the socio-economic development program of the Honorable First Lady and Minister of Human Settlements inasmuch as LEYECO V will be relieved of the responsibility of further serving Ormoc City and, therefore, can concentrate its services more on the eleven (11) neighboring municipalities;

"WHEREAS, it cannot be denied that the way Ormoc City is progressing calls for a power requirement of more than 5 megawatts which makes its separation from the mother cooperative more appropriate and reasonable;

"WHEREAS, the separation of Ormoc City from LEYECO V will also hasten up the electrification program of the government specially in the remote barangays;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Santiago, seconded unanimously by all the other Mga Kagawad present; be it

"RESOLVED, to earnestly request the Honorable First Lady and Minister of Human Settlements, through the Honorable Minister of Energy, the President of the National Power Corporation, and the National Electrification Administrator, to allow Ormoc City to organize its own electric cooperative separate from the Leyte V Electric Cooperative (LEYECO V), Inc.; and be it

"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution each to Madam Imelda Romuladez-Marcos, Minister of Human Settlements, and Hon. Geronimo Velasco, Minister of Energy, Office of the President, both in Malacañang, Hon. Gabriel Y. Itchon, President, National Power Corporation, Quezon Avenue corner BIR Road, Diliman, Quezon City, and Gen. Pedro Dumol, Administrator, National Electrification Administration, 10050 Quezon Avenue, Quezon City, all in Metro Manila; and the General Manager and the Board of Directors, LEYECO V, Inc., both in Ormoc City;
