"WHEREAS, we greatly share the grief and sorrow with his loving wife, Mrs. Corazon Cojuangco-Aquino, the melancholy and gloom with his children, Maria Elena, Aurora, Victoria, Kristine and Benigno III, the sadness and woe with his mother, Mrs. Aurora A. Aquino, and the anguish and pain with his sister, Lupita, as well as his brother-in-law, Mr. Ken Kashiwahara, for the untimely passing away of a caressing husband, a loving father, a gentle son and a complaisant brother and in-law who was formerly a municipal mayor, a provincial governor, and then a senator who could have been of more and better service to his native land were he to live longer through the years;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Samson, seconded unanimously by all the other Mga Kagawad present; be it

"RESOLVED, to express our most profound sympathy by way of condolence to the bereaved family and other relatives for the untimely death of Senator Benigno S. Aquino, Jr., and do, as this Body hereby does, join in mourning with them in this, their hour of bereavement;

"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to reflect this resolution immediately in a telegram to the widow, Mrs. Corazon Cojuangco-Aquino; and be it


