RESOLUTION NO. 1606

A RESOLUTION TO INQUIRE FROM THE ABOITIZ SHIPPING CORPORATION IF
THEY COULD NOT ANYMORE IMPROVE THEIR ORMOC-MANILA-ROUTE
SERVICES DESPITE THEIR PROMISES MADE, CONSIDERING THAT
SAID SERVICES HAVE DETERIORATED TO THE LOWEST LEVEL.

"WHEREAS, Manila-bound shippers and passengers are again clamoring for better services of the Aboitiz Shipping Corporation, specially in the matter of arrival and departure schedules which have now become so irregular that many of said shippers and passengers have been marooned in Ormoc City;

"WHEREAS, to cite just a recent instance, in the past week, a large cattle shipper from Calubian, Leyte, was promised and assured by the management that M/V Cotabato, which replaced the M/V Elcano, would arrive early dawn of Sunday but actually arrived yesterday, Monday, in the afternoon, which delay forced him to slaughter two heads of large cattle causing him some losses that could have been averted if only the vessel went on schedule;

"WHEREAS, the irregular arrivals and departures of Aboitiz Shipping vessels have already caused so much damage and untold miseries to the riding public coming from not only Ormoc City but also the neighboring municipalities;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Besabella, seconded jointly by Mga Kagawad Tugonon and Larrazabal; be it

"RESOLVED, to inquire from the Aboitiz Shipping Corporation if they could not anymore improve their Ormoc-Manila-route services in spite of their promises made, considering that said services have already deteriorated to the lowest level; and

"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution each to Mr. Jon R. Aboitiz, General Manager, Aboitiz Shipping Corporation, through the Resident Manager in Ormoc City, and to Capt. Victorino A. Basco, Administrator, Maritime Industry Authority, PPL Building UN Avenue, Metro Manila;

"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."
