RESOLUTION NO. 1621

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT RESOLUTION NO. 2178 OF THE HONORABLE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD NG LUCENA EARNESTLY REQUESTING PRESIDENT FERDINAND E. MARCOS TO RECONSIDER AND HOLD IN ABEYANCE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF P.D. 1934 IMPOSING ADDITIONAL FEES AND TAX BURDEN OF MOTOR VEHICLE OWNERS.

"WHEREAS, the Honorable Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Lucena has furnished for our adoption their Resolution No. 2178 earnestly requesting His Excellency, President Ferdinand E. Marcos, to reconsider and hold in abeyance the implementation of Presidential Decree 1934 which imposes additional fees and tax burden on motor vehicle owners;

"WHEREAS, we concur in the embodiment of the resolution that the taxpayers are now over-burdened by rising prices of all prime commodities coupled with slow-paced salary increases and other emoluments to cope with the trend of time and here comes P.D. 1934 which, although imposed on motor vehicle owners, will ultimately affect the taxpayers who mostly depend on public transportation in the pursuit of their trade or occupation;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Torrevillas, seconded unanimously by all the other Kagawad present; be it

"RESOLVED, to adopt Resolution No. 2178 of the Honorable Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Lucena and do, as this Body hereby does, earnestly request His Excellency, President Ferdinand E. Marcos, to reconsider and hold in abeyance the implementation of Presidential Decree 1934 imposing additional fees and tax burden of motor vehicle owners; and

"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution each to His Excellency, President Ferdinand E. Marcos, Malacañang, Metro Manila; and the Honorable Sangguniang Panlungsod, Lucena City;
