RESOLUTION NO. 1702

A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY ENDORSING THE REQUEST OF THE PRESIDENT, FEDERATION OF THE ELECTRIC COOPERATIVES IN THE PHILIPPINES, AMONG OTHERS, REQUESTING HIS EXCELLENCY PRESIDENT FERDINAND E. MARCOS AND HONORABLE FIRST LADY MADAME IMELDA ROMUALDEZ-MARCOS TO KINDLY SUSPEND THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PRESIDENTIAL DECREES NOS. 1931 AND 1955

"WHEREAS, the General Manager of the Federation of Electric Cooperatives of the Philippines, Quezon City in his communication of the 29th of January 1985, among others informing us of the impact of PD 1931 and 1955, withdrawing tax exemptions and privileges from government corporations and private businesses, insofar as electric rates are concerned;

"WHEREAS, PD 231 withdraws tax exemption formerly enjoyed by the National Power Corporation (NPO) from where the electric cooperatives buy their power, and the National Electrification Administration (NEA) from where they get their loans and materials, for this, NPO has increased its rates by an average of P0.08/KWH and likewise NEA will be purchasing materials at a much higher price, chargeable against the coop loans. These additional costs are to be charged on the electric cooperatives who, in turn passes these on to their member-consumers;

"WHEREAS, PD 1955 withdraws tax exemptions formerly enjoyed by electric cooperatives, thus the coops will now pay all taxes and to cover these, they will raise their rates by more than P0.10/KWH;

"WHEREAS, the effects call for an increase of P0.20/KWH or more on the present rates of electric cooperatives and it could be noted that consumers pay taxes twice for the power purchase, and as some taxes are imposed on percentage basis; those paying higher electric rates are taxed more;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Larrazabal, unanimously seconded by all the other Mga Kagawad present; be it

"RESOLVED, to favorably endorse the request of the President, Federation of the Electric Cooperatives in the Philippines among others requesting His Excellency President, Ferdinand E. Marcos and the Honorable First Lady Madame Imelda Romualdez Marcos to kindly suspend the implementation of Presidential Decrees Nos. 1931 and 1955;
