RESOLUTION NO. 1734

A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE HONORAGLE MINISTER OF THE MINISTRY OF LABOR & EMPLOYMENT, THE HONORABLE BLAS OPLE, TO EXTEND AID TO THE DISPLACED SUGAR WORKERS AND THEIR DE-PENDENTS BY ALLOTTING A CERTAIN AMOUNT TO THE ORNOG CITY TECHNOLOGICAL, MAN POWER TRAINING & RESEARCH CENTER TO BE USED FOR THE TRAINING OF NUMEROUS SUGAR WORKERS AND DEPEN-DENTS PRESENTLY DISPLACED AND ENROLLED IN DIFFERENT TECH-NICAL COURSES FOR THEIR ALTERNATIVE LIVELIHOOD.

WHEREAS, the City of Ormoc has been, and is suffering the effects of the slump of the sugar industry presently obtaining in the country.

WHEREAS, the City of Ormoc is solely dependent upon the sugar industry which is the mainstay of its economy;

WHEREAS, due to the after effects of the slump of the sugar industry the majority of the work force of the industry which comprises the majority of the residents of the City's country-side are in very dire straights due to mass lay-off because of the uncertainty and the financial problems encountered by the Sugar planters of Ormoc City;

WHEREAS, if the prevailing situation is not eased the problem of dissidence may become the major threat to the peace and order situation of the city;

WHITEAS, many sugar workers and their dependents have enrolled in the Manpower Training programs of the City but up to the present, the continuation of the training courses is imperilled due to the absence of funding from the Regional Office of the National Manpower & Youth Council of Region 8:

which is geared towards export of laborers skilled in technical courses in demand in the Middle East cannot be borne by the City alone due also to the financial constraints of the City brought about by the closing up of the Biophil, Inc., and other factors, such as the slump of the sugar industry and its related industries;

WHEREAS, it is imperative that the manpower training programs of the City be given a boost in order to solve, if not, alleviate the rising threat of dissidence to the City, which may be aggravated if alternative livelihood skills and job placements cannot be offered or found;
