RESOLUTION NO. 101

A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE MINISTER, MINISTRY TREASURER OF DRMOC CITY TO RETAIN THE 20% SHARE FOR THE FOURTH QUARTER OF 1986 AND FOR THE YEAR 1987 FROM PROCEEDS OF THE ADDITIONAL 1% PROPERTY TAX LEVIED FOR THE SPECIAL EDUCATION FUND (SEF) CREATED UNDER RA 5447 WHICH THE CITY REMITS TO THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT QUARTERLY.

"WHEREAS, the Local School Board has passed Resolution No.4,s. 1986, among others requesting the Minister of Education Culture and Sports to allow the Local School Board of Ormoc City to retain the 20% share of the national government from the proceeds of the additional 1% property tax levied for the Special Education Fund (SEF) created under RA 5447 as amended;

"WHEREAS, the City Government is fully aware of the fact that education is an essential factor in the economic growth of the nation and is a productive investment of vital importance;

"WHEREAS, we are likewise aware of the sad plight of public school teachers whose salaries under the present conditions do not both ends

WHEREAS, it has been the policy of the present city administration of Ormoc to promote and improve the social and economic conditions of our poor public school teachers by augmenting their income with supplementary benefits as provided by law like the cost of living allowance which the city government has granted them in addition to what they have been receiving from the national government;

"WHEREAS, teacher's salaries shall at the very least keep pace with the rise in the cost of living allowances which shall automatically follow changes in a cost of living index;

"WHEREAS, it is said to state that the status of our Special Education Fund does not warrant such on account of the poor tax collections brought about by the slump in the sugar industry which Ormoc City has been adversely affected;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Subingsubing and unanimously seconded; be it

"RESOLVED, to earnestly request the Honorable Minister, Ministry of Finance to authorize the City Treasurer of Ormoc City to retain the 20% share for the fourth quarter of 1986 and for the year 1987 from proceeds of the additional 1% property tax levied for the Special Education Fund (SEF) created under RA 5447 which we remit to the national government quarterly;

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution each to the Honorable Minister Jaime V. Ongpin, Ministry of Finance; the Honorable Lourdes R. Quisumbing, MECS Minister; the Honorable Minister Alfredo C. Romulo, Ministry of Budget; all in Metro Manila; the Officer In-Charge, Ormoc City Division Office; the City Treasurer, the City Budget Officer; all in Ormoc City;

"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."
