RESOLUTION NO. 39

A RESOLUTION CALLING THE ATTENTION OF THE POLLUTION CONTROL OFFICER OF ORMOC CITY REGARDING THE POLLUTION IN BARANGAY LILO-AN AND OTHER NEIGHBORING AFFECTED AREAS

"WHEREAS, Kagawad Sumaljag has presented the pollution problem of barrangay Lilo-an and other neighboring affected areas;

"WHEREAS, Kagawad Suan manifested that the pollution does not only affect Barangay Lilo-an but also the Pagsanga-an river, the cause of which is the clearing of HIDECO every three months and everytime that is cleared it is discharged to Bao river and extends to Pagsanga-an down to the sea and all the fishes in Pagsanga-an river are poisoned;

"WHEREAS, on June 15, 1986 Mr. Manuel T. Quilantang, by virtue of the letter sent to him by the Honorable Papiano L. Santo, Provincial Fiscal of Leyte, directing him to pay his indebtedness to the Bao River Irrigation System within ten (10) days from receipt responded that after signing a document acknowledging his indebtedness he informed verbally the Inspector from Manila and other representatives of the irrigation system to ask the NIA to stop their water from passing through his land, first, as it was illegally constructed without his consent and secondly; because the water, being polluted on account of Tungonan and HIDECO Sugar Mill caused damage to his crops and later he wrote NIA to cut the water connection to his farm but until now no action has been taken thereon. This letter to Honorable Papiano L. Santo is being made in order that the damage of his crops be avoided and so that he may not be billed of and made to pay for water that he neither needed nor wanted. Henceforth, he would welcome a confrontation through the Office of Honorable Provincial Fiscal of Leyte, Government Center, Palo, Leyte to set things straight and to avoid further inconvenience;

"WHEREAS, on June 20, 1986 Mr. Manuel Quilantang again, wrote a letter to the Supervisor, Bao Irrigation Project, Valencia, Ormoc City, informing of the pollution analysis of the Office of the NIA, dated December 8, 1980 which pollution has already spread up to his area thereby causing a very remarkable drop of their production and soil pollution;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Sumaljag, jointly seconded by Kagawad Subingsubing and Hermosilla; be it

RESOLVED, to call the attention of the Pollution Control Officer of Ormoc City regarding the pollution in Barangay Lilo-an and other neighboring affected areas to make necessary steps to remedy the situation;
