RESOLUTION NO. 52

A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING HER EXCELLENCY MADAME CORAZON C. AQUINO, PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES FOR THE DIVISION OF LEYTE INTO TWO PROVINCES AS EASTERN AND WESTERN LEYTE, WITH ORMOC CITY AS A CAPITAL OF THE WESTERN PART.

"WHEREAS, there has been a serious discussion by responsible citizens in Ormoc City and nearby towns for the division of Leyte into two provinces;

"WHEREAS, Ormoc City and its neighboring towns are having inconveniences in some aspects as to their going to Tacloban City like for example for the registration of Torrens Title, Annotations and some other matters which requires the Provincial Capital which is Tacloban City and it is the distance in going there that they are really concerned;

"WHEREAS, the basic qualification to separate a certain area from the mother province is that the towns which will be incorporated into another province should have at least a population of no less than 500,000 and the net income should not be less than P10M, of which these two basic requirements will do to become a province;

"WHEREAS, to recall the districts of Leyte has four districts, and the 1st and 2nd districts on the eastern part and the 3rd and 4th districts on the western part. The boundaries of these districts are so ideal that practically divide Leyte into almost equal boundaries;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Redoña, seconded by all the rest of the Kagawads present; be it

"RESOLVED, to earnestly request Her Excellency Madame Corazon C. Aquino, President of the Philippines for the division of Leyte into two provinces as Eastern and Western Leyte, with Ormoc City as a capital in the Western part;

"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution each to Her Excellency President Corazon C. Aquino, Malacañang, an all neighboring towns previously under the 3rd and 4th districts for support;

"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."
