## RESOLUTION NO. 139

A RESOLUTION OF CONDOLENCE TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY AND CLAN OF  
THE LATE EX- MAYOR INAKI A. LARRAZABAL, SR.

"WHEREAS, we have been filled with grief over the sudden and untimely death of a dearly loved and highly esteemed Ex-Mayor Inaki A. Larrazabal, Sr., who succumbed late in the evening last December 31, 1986 at the Cebu Doctor's Hospital, Cebu City;

"WHEREAS, as we all know while the Philippines was growing and deteriorating under the 20-year rule of Marcos the opposite was happening in our beloved city of Ormoc which was under the able administration of our just departed Ex-Mayor Inaki A. Larrazabal, Sr. For during his 20-years of mayorship of Ormoc, AKI, as he was fondly called by everybody in Ormoc, had brought Ormoc to its present status of a financially stable, peaceful and beautiful city. It was not only his link or as he was wont to say, the bridge to Malacanang but also his dedication, vision and commitment to his job that brought about a lot of bounty and progress to our beloved city. It is without doubt that AKI had carved an inviable niche in the history of Ormoc City setting up a high yardstick for any future Mayor to measure his own achievements. Though he had not acquired higher educational attainment yet he proved that one can achieve great heights by sheer determination, sincerity of purpose, iron-willed leadership and great love for our city and its constituencies. For this he has earned the distinct honor of being the best Mayor Ormoc City ever had. His life - struggle from a virtual unknown political figure and his rise to prominence - is indeed worthwhile emulating;



"WHEREAS, reckoning back to his service in the government he was first appointed as Mayor in March, 1948 to May, 1949; elected Councilor in January, 1952 to May, 1953; appointed again Mayor in June, 1953 to December, 1953; and again elected Councilor in January, 1956 to December 1959; and lastly elected Mayor in January, 1968 to March 31, 1986;

"WHEREAS, we gravely feel the irreparable loss of a conscientious and freedom-loving Mayor Inaki A. Larrazabal, Sr. whose outstanding record of public service bear witness to his achievements for the benefit and welfare of the people of Ormoc in particular and for the real progress and prosperity of Ormoc City in general;

"WHEREAS, Aki during his terms of office has won for himself the distinction of a scrupulous Mayor of Ormoc City remaining faithful to his avowed duties and responsibilities, a devoted public servant dedicating the best years of his life to the people of Ormoc whose common weal has been his primordial concern and a self-made man whose sole aim was to make this city of ours a better place to live in;

"WHEREAS, we greatly share the grief and sorrow with Mrs. Pura-Pongos Larrazabal, her sons and daughters, and the sadness and woes with the in-laws, brothers, sisters, nephews, grandchildren, and other relatives of the late Ex-Mayor Inaki A. Larrazabal, Sr. for the passing away of a caressing husband, a dutiful father and an accommodating kin;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Vrastorza, unanimously seconded, be it;

"RESOLVED, to express our deepest sympathy by way of condolence to Mrs. Pura-Pongos Larrazabal, her brothers, sisters, in-laws, nephews, nieces, grandchildren and other relatives for the untimely death of her husband, the late Ex-Mayor Inaki A. Larrazabal, Sr., and do, as this Body hereby does, join in mourning and profoundly share in grief and sorrow, anguish and pain, sadness and woes of the bereaved family and clan on this, their hour of bereavement;
