RESOLUTION NO. 140

A RESOLUTION OF CONDOLENCE TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY AND
CLAN OF THE LATE ATTY. CONRADO S. SABELINO

"WHEREAS, we have been deeply shocked over the sudden death of Atty. Conrado S. Sabelino in the evening of Saturday, January 3, 1987 at the OSPA Hospital, Ormoc City;

"WHEREAS, the late Atty. Conrado S. Sabelino, the beloved father of the incumbent Secretary of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, this city, has served our city for so many years and has given honor to his native place. He had been a 2nd Lieutenant of the USAFFE on December 29, 1941; assigned to Headquarter Visayas-Mindanao Forces at Del Monte, Bukidnon in the Staff of Brig. Gen. William F. Sharp; joined the Western Leyte Guerrilla Warfare Forces as General Staff Member in the grade of Lt. Col.; returned to Military Control on December 1944; assigned office of the 1st Leyte MP Company AFWESPAC then PA (1944-47); detachment Comdr. and later Adjutant MPC-Ormoc & Tacloban (1947-48); Commanding Officer 514th MP Co. Camp Downes, Ormoc City; graduated Military Police School in Bagban, Tarlac in 1947; graduated Company Grade School, Ft. Wm. McKinley, Rizal in 1949; assigned Commandant of ROTC in Tacloban and MO in Calocan in 1950-52; assigned Instructor and later Associate Professor in English and Social Sciences in the Philippine Military Academy in 1953-1960; took up special studies, Strategic Intelligence Course, Ft. Bonifacio; assigned Asst. Military Attache, Philippine Embassy at Washington, D. C. in 1961-62; and retired from the AFP in the grade of Lt. Col., Inf. 1963. Not only these he has served Ormoc City in many ways like being a member of religious and other civic organizations, and a practicing lawyer in Ormoc;

"WHEREAS, we greatly share the grief and sorrows with his loving wife Mrs. Teopista Calibo-Sabelino and family, and the sadness and woes

of his beloved children and in-laws, nephews, nieces, grandchildren and other relatives for the untimely passing away of a caressing husband, a responsible father, a complaisant in-law, an accommodating grandfather and an ever-loving brother who could have been more useful to his community in particular and to his country in general, were he to live longer through the years;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Suan, unanimously seconded be it;

"RESOLVED, to express our most profound sympathy by way of this resolution of condolence to the bereaved widow and family and clan for the untimely death of Atty. Conrado S. Sabelino and do, as this Body hereby does, join in mourning with the family and all other relatives of the deceased in this, their hour of bereavement; and be it
