BANGUS AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE.

"WHEREAS, Lake Danaog in Ormoc City is popularly known as one of
the tourist spots wherein people of all walks of life crowds to relax by
seeing the aesthetic view of the lake and its surroundings;

"WHEREAS, it is imperative that Lake Danaog be re-stocked for the
maintenance of its beauty and ecology and to forestall the disappearance
of fishes and other varieties therein;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Hermosilla, jointly seconded
by Mga Kagawad Yrastorza and Subingsubing; be it

"RESOLVED, to earnestly request the Bureau of Fisheries and
Aquatic Resources (BFAR) to re-stock Lake Danaog with Tilapia, Carp and
Bangus as early as possible;

Mayor, both in Ormoc City




