"WHEREAS, the Ormocanons have been shocked to hear of the untimely demise of the late Honorable Jaime N. Ferrer, in the evening of Sunday, August 2, 1987 from an ambush staged by heavily armed men, who up to his death was the Secretary of Local Governments;

Ferrer was a champion of freedom and democracy; one of the very best officials we have had in the government, past and present; and an exceptional and exemplary public servant, courageous and kind; a very good man who was a fighter and martyr for human rights; the staunchest supporter and pillar for the restoration of freedom, with a superb public record;

"WHEREAS, we greatly share the grief and sorrow with Mrs. Eriberta Ferrer, his loving wife, the sadness and woe of his beloved children, Grace, Tirso, Totie (who is in Australia), and Jaime Jr. (who is in New York), and other relatives and friends from all walks of life, for the untimely loss of a caressing husband, loving father and everloving brother, a conscientious and selfless government servant who could have been more useful to his community in particular and to his country in general were he to live longer through the years;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Yrastorza, unanimously seconded; be it

"RESOLVED, to express our deepest sympathy by way of condolence to Mrs. Eriberta Ferrer, and his children and other relatives for the untimely demise of her husband the late Honorable Jaime N.
