"WHEREAS, it is elementary that in order to preserve and enhance economic growth of the city so that political stability be attained is necessary that our police forces be on efficient footing;

this august Body believes that it is incumbent upon higher echelon to furnish the Ormoc City Police Department said equipment considering that the city has not been remiss in its remittance of its share to the INP;
