RESOLUTION NO. 324

A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY AND URGENTLY REQUESTING GENERAL FIDEL V. RAMOS, CHIEF OF STAFF, ARMED FORCES OF THE PHILIPPINES, TO FURNISH THREE (3) SERVICE VEHICLES TO THE ORMOC CITY INTEGRATED NATIONAL POLICE.

"WHEREAS, the Ormoc City Police Force has only one (1) service vehicle which for all aims and purposes as far as police work in Ormoc City is concerned, does not suffice for an efficient maintenance of peace and order;

"WHEREAS, due to an abnormal breakdown in peace and order in the city, two (2) vehicles belonging to the SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD NG ORMOC has been lent to the Ormoc City Police Department which also results in the inefficient function of the said body in attending to the needs of the city's constituents;

"WHEREAS, with the spate of crimes against persons and property in the city, the lack of mobility of our city police forces results in a rise of criminality in the city so much so that the concerned citizens of the city have already been vocal in their complaints to the local administration;

"WHEREAS, it is elementary that in order to preserve and enhance the economic growth of the city so that political stability be attained it is necessary that our police forces be on efficient footing;

"WHEREAS, this august Body believes that it is incumbent upon higher echelon to furnish the Ormoc City Police Department said equipment considering that the city has not been remiss in its remittance of its share to the INP;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Romeo M. Hermosilla, jointly and severally seconded by Kagawads Sofronio S. Aguiro, Ricardo L. Martinez and Ram F. Capahi; be it

"RESOLVED, to earnestly and urgently request General Fidel V. Ramos, Chief of Staff, Armed Forces of the Philippines, to furnish two (2) units service vehicles to the Ormoc City Integrated National Police;


