RESOLUTION NO. 107

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE REGIONAL DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS TO MAKE A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF THE ISLANDS AT THE JUNCTION OF BARANGAYS SAN PABLO (SIMANGAN) AND DOLORES AND TO REQUEST ANY AGENCY TO CONDUCT A STUDY TO REDESIGN THE ISLANDS INTO A SINGLE ISLAND, TO BE MOVED TO THE CENTER.

WHEREAS, this august Body is in receipt of the communication from the Ormoc Supreme Lions Club through its President James S. Leones requesting that they be authorized to develop exclusively the islands of the highway junction at San Pablo (Simangan) and Dolores;

WHEREAS, on October 10, 1988 the Committee on Zoning and Beautification of the Fifth Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc chaired by Hon. Antero T. Fiel conducted a conference inviting thereof Mr. James S. Leones, (President), Engr. Romeo T. Bautista, Mr. Pelagio Brazil, Jr. and Engr. Aquilino T. Lasaca of the Ormoc Supreme Lions Club; and Engr. Ruben C. Peneerga, City Engineer, City Engineering Office, and Engr. Ramon C. Omega, Asst. District Engineer, 2ND LED; wherein Messrs James S. Leones and Pelagio Brazil, Jr. spearheaded the proposal that the monumental Welcome Sign be erected therein;

WHEREAS, Kagawad Antero T. Fiel, in his capacity as Chairman on Zoning and Beautification, Fifth Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, stressed the point that the monumental Welcome Sign to be erected might be affected in the future if there will be a redesigning of the islands, because there are already countless complaints of the drivers regarding the confusing direction of its route, especially by those coming from Barangay Dolores when the intersection is viewed from afar, moreover several accidents had already occurred at the said junction, thus, in order to avoid accidents and other untoward incidents and also in order to enhance the flow of traffic there is a need to redesign the islands of said junction;

WHEREAS, inasmuch as the city government of Ormoc does not have authority to grant the request of the Ormoc Supreme Lions Club to erect a monumental Welcome Sign at the junction of Barangays San Pablo (Simangan) and Dolores and it being very important that the islands at the junction be redesigned, thus, a thorough study is necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Antero T. Fiel, jointly seconded by Mga Kagawad Celso P. Adolfo and Arnulfo C. Salazar; be it

RESOLVED, to earnestly request the Regional Director, Department of Public Works & Highways to make a feasibility study of the islands at the junction of Barangays San Pablo (Simangan) and Dolores and to request any agency to conduct study to redesign the islands into a single island, to be moved to the center;

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution each to the Regional Director, Department of Public Works & Highways, Government Center, Palo Leyte for his immediate consideration and approval; the Honorable City Mayor, Ormoc City and the Ormoc Supreme Lions Club through its President Mr. James S. Leones, Ormoc City and the City Engineer, Ormoc City.
