RESOLUTION NO. 167

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND APPROVING THE LIST OF PRIORITY PRO-
JECTS THAT ARE TO BE FUNDED THRU NALGU-DLG FUND.

WHEREAS, during the meeting of the City Planning and Development Board last December 15, 1988 the following projects were deliberated and approved by said Board as recommended by Engr. Ruben C. Penserga that are to be funded thru the National Aid to Local Government Units (NALGU) and the Department of Local Government Fund in the amount of P5,000,000.00, per DLG Memorandum Circular No. 88-61 dated Nov. 17, 1988 thus:

1. The construction of the Public Administration Building, in an estimated amount of P500,000.00 is the top priority.
2. Construction of the Lotao Double Box Culvert, Ormoc-Linao Naungan Road, in an estimated amount of P490,000.00- The construction of a permanent structure such as concrete box culvert to replace the existing timber trestle will ensure a continuous flow of traffic along the highly urbanized barangays of Punta-Linao and Naungan;
3. Construction of the Ormoc Drainage along Navarro and Arradaza sts., in an estimated amount of P400,000.00.- The construction to replace the existing open canal will greatly improve sanitation and lessen occurrence of traffic accidents as the open canal will be covered by a concrete sidewalk with curb and gutter;
4. Improvement of the Ormoc Slaughterhouse, Brgy. Alegria, Ormoc City, in an estimated amount of P400,000.00.- The construction of a toilet at the City Abattoir is very necessary to enhance sanitation. It is very necessary to eliminate the abundance of flies at the slaughterhouse, which is detrimental to the health of the people in the vicinity in particular and the people of Ormoc in general, hence, the construction of a large septic tank for the waste of butchered animal;
5. Construction of Margen Bakante Footbridge, Brgy. San Juan, Ormoc City, in an estimated amount of P480,000.00.- The construction of a footbridge will eliminate the danger of crossing river by banca and other small sea craft which is often swollen. The envisioned footbridge will greatly improve commerce in this area as agricultural products are easily marketed and goods from the city are easily availed by the people in the area; and
6. Construction of two units single barrel box culverts along Merida-Ormoc National Road, in an estimated amount of P800,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Gregorio A. Yrastorza Jr., severally seconded by Mga Kagawad Sixto T. Pongos, Celso P. Porcadilla and Romeo M. Hermosilla; be it

RESOLVED, to adopt the list of priority projects that are to be funded thru NALGU-DLG Fund; thus:

- 1) The construction of the Public Market Administration Building, P500,000.00;
- 2) Construction of the Lotao Double Box Culvert, Ormoc-Linao-Naungan Road, P490,000.00;
- 3) Construction of the Ormoc City Drainage specifically the Navarro & Arradaza Sts., P400,000.00;
- 4) Development of the City Livestock Market and Improvement of the Slaughterhouse, P400,000.00;
- 5) Construction of Margen-Bakante Footbridge, P80,000.00;
- 6) Construction of two units Single Barrel Box Culverts along Merida-Ormoc National Road, P800,000.00 for a total of P2,670,000.00.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution each to Honorable Secretary of the Department of Local Government, Manila; Hon. Congressman Carmelo J. Locsin, House of Representatives, Manila; the Regional Director, DLG, Tacloban City; Her Honor, the City Mayor, Ormoc City; and the City Engineer, Ormoc City;
