

RESOLUTION NO. 35

A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING RECEIPT OF THE NEWSPAPER CLIPPINGS ON
HOUSE BILL NO. 4695 OF CONGRESSMAN OSCAR SANTOS REPRESENTATIVE 4TH
DISTRICT OF QUEZON AND EXPRESSING FULL SUPPORT OF THE SAME.

"WHEREAS, this august Body is in receipt of newspaper clippings on
House Bill No. 4695 sent by Honorable Congressman Oscar Santos,
Representative 4th District of Quezon asking full support of the bill;

"WHEREAS, the purpose of which is to make a gradual phase out of
local and foreign recruitment agencies until 1992 to protect Filipino
workers from further abuse by local and foreign recruiters;

"WHEREAS, the bill also, grants the Philippine Overseas Employment
Administration as well as government and private employment offices who
pay their workers directly and charge no unnecessary fees the exclusive
right of recruiting Filipinos for overseas contracts and apparently with
the increased role of the POEA, government-to-government agreements
would assure Filipinos better treatment from foreign employers;

"WHEREAS, it is apparent to support House Bill No. 4695 because it
attributes to the protection and general welfare of our Filipino workers
who are wishing to work abroad;

District of Quezon and to express full support of the same;


