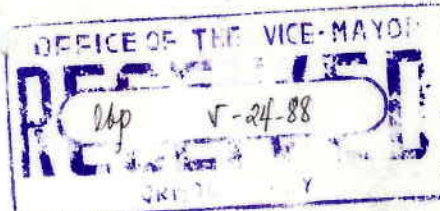

RESOLUTION NO. 43

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE HONORABLE AGUILINO Q. PIMENTEL, JR.,
CHAIRMAN, SENATE COMMITTEE ON LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND THE HONORABLE
CARMELO J. LOCSIN, CONGRESSMAN, 4TH DISTRICT OF LEYTE, TO SPONSOR A
BILL TO AMEND THE PROVISIONS OF THE PRESIDENTIAL DECREE RELATIVE
TO THE CREATION OF THE PHILIPPINE PORTS AUTHORITY, TO THE EFFECT
THAT THE CONTROL AND THE SUPERVISION OF ALL THE SUB-PORTS
THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY BE RETURNED TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENTS.

"WHEREAS, the then First Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc will
remember having passed Resolution No. 744 dated November 27, 1979,
earnestly requesting the Philippine Ports Authority to convert the Port
of Ormoc into a National Port or a Port of Entry;

"WHEREAS, after which President Ferdinand E. Marcos issued a
Presidential Decree creating the Philippine Ports Authority of which its
main functions was to control and supervise the entire sub-ports in the
country;

"WHEREAS, it is of public knowledge that the pier of Ormoc is
deteriorating, badly dilapidated and very much congested because of its
management or absence of it for years now, thus obviously having created
considerable complaints coming from the commuters;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Romeo M. Hermosilla, duly
seconded by Kagawad Celso P. Adolfo; be it

"RESOLVED, to request the Honorable Aquilino Q. Pimentel, Jr.,
Chairman, Senate Committee on Local Government and the Honorable Carmelo
J. Locsin, Congressman, 4th District of Leyte, to sponsor a bill to
amend the provisions of the Presidential Decree relative to the creation
of the Philippine Ports Authority to the effect that the control and
supervision of all the sub-ports throughout the country be returned to
the local governments.

"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution each to the Honorable Aquilino Q. Pimentel, Jr., Chairman, Senate Committee on Local Government and Honorable Carmelo J. Locsin, Congressman, 4th District of Leyte, both in Congress of the Philippines, the General Manager, Philippine Ports Authority, Aduana, Intramuros, Manila; and Her Honor, the City Mayor, Ormoc City;
