RESOLUTION NO. 65

A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE CARMELO J. LOCSIN, CONGRESSMAN, 4TH DISTRICT, LEYTE, TO MAKE REPRESENTATIONS WITH THE EMBASSY OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY TO INCLUDE A BARANGAY IN ORMOC CITY AS ONE OF THE RECIPIENTS OF A SOLAR-POWERED WATER PUMP DISPERSAL PROGRAM AS MANIFESTED BY MR. EBERHARD BIERMANN, PROJECT SPOKESMAN FOR THE GERMAN AGENCY FOR TECHNICAL COOPERATION (GTI) AND MR. FRANZ DIEDERICH, DIRECTOR FOR ACADEMIC AFFAIRS OF THE TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY OF AACHEN'S RESEARCH INSTITUTE FOR INTERNATIONAL TECHNO- **ECONOMIC COOPERATION.

WHEREAS, the Federal Republic of Germany is ready to provide 15 to 20 solar-powered water pumps to selected areas in the country;

WHEREAS, there are certain barangays in Ormoc City which do not enjoy a supply of potable water because their water source are below the level of the barangay proper and the chore of fetching potable water is a taxing problem;

WHEREAS, such water resources can be harnessed by the use of electrically powered water pumps but the prohibitive cost of such power is beyond the reach of the lowly barangay residents;

WHEREAS, the discovery of solar power has offered a cheap alternative source of electrical energy to fossil fuel-powered or mechanically induced electrical power with which to run electrical-powered water pumps;

WHEREAS, as of the present, Barangay Cabingtan in Ormoc City is confronted for such a long time with this problem of bringing potable water to the residents of their barangay;

Locsin, Congressman, 4th District, Leyte, to make representations with the Embassy of the Federal Republic of Germany to include one barangay in Ormoc City as a recipient of a unit of solar-powered water pump, as manifested by Mr. Eberhard Biermann, project spokesman for the German Agency for Technical Cooperation (GTI) and Mr. Franz Diederich, Director for Academic Affairs of the Technical University of Aachen's Research Institute for International Techno-Economic Cooperation;

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish immediately a copy of this resolution to the Honorable Congressman Carmelo J. Locsin, 4th District, Leyte, at the House of Representatives, Manila; to His Excellency, the German Ambassador, at the Embassy of the Federal Republic of Germany and to Ms. Josefina N. Ruiz, Officer-in-charge, LWUA, Manila; to Hon. Ma. Victoria L. Locsin, City Mayor, Ormoc City; to Engr. Nestor C. Penserga, Waterworks Supervisor, Ormoc City and to Hon. Pastor P. Metran Punong Barangay of Barangay Cabingtan, Ormoc City.
