

RESOLUTION NO. 69

EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE ASSISTANCE OF HONORABLE A RESOLUTION CARMELO J. LOCSIN, CONGRESSMAN ATH DISTRICT OF LEYTE TO SPONSOR A BILL IN CONGRESS SEGREGATING A PORTION OF THE MILITARY RESERVATION KNOWN AS CAMP DOWNES IN ORMOC CITY TO ESTABLISH A BARANGAY TERRITORY AND THE LOTS THEREIN BE SOLD OR LEASED TO ACTUAL OCCUPANTS.

WHEREAS, this august Body thru Hon. Na. Victoria L. Locsin passed a Resolution No. 66, Series of 1988 supplicating Her Excellency President Corazon C. Aquino to accede to the request of the Barangay Council and inhabitants of Barangay Camp Downes situated within the Military Reservation of Camp Downes, Ormoc City be sold on installment basis or leased to the actual occupants therein;

WHEREAS, the inhabitants of said barangay are occupying semipermanent houses in this military reservation erected along the seashore on the west side of the national highway and on the east side of said below the slopes of the hills and plateau of the military reservation of Camp Downes so that actually the lots which will be segregated and sold or leased does not affect, hamper or impede the activities of the military personnel because the camp with its headquarters, barracks and wide training grounds is located on the top of the plateau;

WHEREAS, there are more than two thousand inhabitants living in this portion of the military reservation who are families of personnel of the New Armed Forces of the Philippines, families of retired military personnels and veterans and civilians who are surviving family members of deceased military personnels who have been living in this reservation for many years long before said area was created as a Barangay of Grmoc City and even many years before World War II;

WHEREAS, after a meticulous study and inspection conducted by the Kagawad In-Charge of Barangay Camp Downes, Honorable Antero T. Fiel it has been observed and noticed that the statements embodied in the Resolution No. 13, Series of 1988 of the Barangay Council and petition of the residents of said barangay are accurately full of facts and reasonably suitable and acceptable;

WHEREAS, the establishment of a separate barangay territory and the alienation and disposal of properties to actual occupants as early as possible is essential for the promotion of the general welfare of its inhabitants, a bill should be passed in congress to facilitate and achieve expedient, effective and judicious fulfillment for the confirmation of their request and petition;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Antero T. Fiel, seconded by Kagawad Gregorio A. Yrastorza, Jr.; be it

RESOLVED, to earnestly request the assistance of Honorable Carmelo J. Locsin, Congressman 4th District of Leyte to sponsor a bill in congress segregating a portion of the military reservation known as Camp Downes in Ormoc City to establish a barangay territory and the lots therein be sold or leased to actual occupants;

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution each to Honorable Congressman Carmelo J. Locsin, 4th District of Leyte; Her Honor, Hon. Ma. Victoria L. Locsin, City Mayor; Mr. Silvestre D. Valencia, DLG Senior Local Government Officer; Hon. Romeo M. Hermosilla, ABC President and the Barangay Captain and Barangay Council of Barangay Camp Downes, all in Ormoc City;
