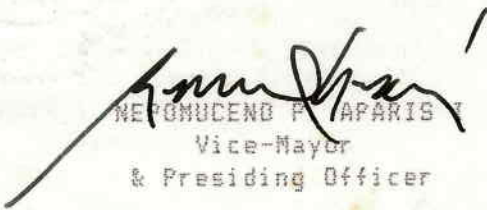
Memorandum of Agreement with said club, through its President, Mrs. Betty Macatual;
