

RESOLUTION NO. 126

A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY AND STRONGLY REQUESTING THE PHILIPPINE PORTS AUTHORITY, (PPA), THROUGH ITS GENERAL MANAGER, MANILA, FOR THE RELEASE OF FUND, AS PROMISED, IN THE AMOUNT OF P19 MILLION FOR THE EXPANSION OF THE PIER IN ORMOC CITY.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Grmoc is in receipt of Resolution No. 1 s. 1989 from the Peace and Order Council, this city, earnestly requesting the Philippine Ports Authority (PPA) for the release of fund amounting to PI9 Million for the expansion of the pier in Grmoc City;

WHEREAS, this august Body fully conforms to the embodiment of the aforesaid resolution that -

- a) the pier in Ormoc City is too small and very narrow to have resulted always in the clogging of cargoes, thus, greatly obstructing the traffic therein,
- b) said pier with only two lanes, (one lane used for the vehicles and the other lane for the stocking of cargoes), could hardly afford people and commuters with the allowance of passage to and from anchored ships and boats;

WHEREAS, as further stated therein, the problems on congestion and obstruction of traffic at said pier, other recommendations and possible remedies were then communicated to higher PPA Personnel in Tacloban City by the PPA Personnel in Grmoc City;

WHEREAS, a promised amount of P19 Million for the expansion of said pier in Ormoc City is not as yet released up to this time;

WHEREAS, this august Body has noted with deep concern the long existing and continuing problems on congestion and traffic obstruction at said pier, and, the URGENCY OF PUBLIC SERVICE to ease out this congestion and enhance the normal flow of traffic therein;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Gregorio A. Yrastorza, Jr., jointly seconded by mga Kagawad Eufrocino C. Codilla, Jr. and Rodolfo L. Rivilla, Jr., be it

RESOLVED, to pass a resolution EARNESTLY AND URGENTLY REQUESTING THE PHILIPPINE PORTS AUTHORITY, (PPA), THROUGH ITS GENERAL MANAGER, MANILA, FOR THE RELEASE OF FUND, AS PROMISED, IN THE AMOUNT OF P19 MILLION FOR THE EXPANSION OF THE PIER IN ORMOC CITY;

ENACTED, September 14, 1989.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish copies of this resolution each to the General Manager Rogelio A. Bayan, Philippine Ports Authority, Port Area, Manila; Honorable Carmelo J. Locsin, Congressman, 4th District, Leyte; Honorable Ma. Victoria L. Locsin, City Mayor, Ormoc City; the PPA Personnel, Tacloban City, and, the PPA Personnel, Ormoc City;
