A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, THROUGH ITS REGIONAL DIRECTOR, TO ESTABLISH A PERMANENT OFFICE IN ORMOC CITY OF LABOR'S CONCALIATION AND MEDIATION SERVICES IN ORDER TO IMMEDIATELY SOLVE OUT LABOR DISPUTES.

WHEREAS, Ormot City which has industrially progressed in the last decade, is no exception to the existence of labor and management disputes then prevailing in many places all over the country;

WHEREAS, at present, a big business establishment in Ormoc City is experiencing a strike of its employees for already a good number of days, to the detriment of the buying public and the possible loss of revenue to the government;

WHEREAS, in the world of trade and commerce, more clashes on many points between labor and management are expected to happen unpredictably in the future as its natural trends or developments;

WHEREAS, there is no entity or agency in Ormoc City that represents the Department of Labor to take charge in preventing or minimizing labor disputes, to assist parties engaged in labor disputes to settle their disputes even through Conciliation and Mediation services, (i.e., through peaceful means and for peaceful solutions without resorting to strikes, lockouts, or other forms of coercion);

WHEREAS, this august Body finds out the establishment of a permanent Office of Labor's Conciliation and Mediation Services in Ormoc City most worthy of its collective consideration, taking into account the enormous inconveniences and unnecessary expenses that parties litigants to labor disputes may incur in going to and from far distant
