RESOLUTION NO. 133

A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR TO
DECLARE OCTOBER 8, 1989 AS "LIONS SERVICE DAY" IN ORMOC CITY.

WHEREAS, three (3) Lions Clubs combined in Ormoc City, namely, the Ormoc City Host Lions Club, the Ormoc Supreme Lions Club and the Ormoc Uptown Lions Club, has collectively written a letter dated October 1, 1989 to Her Honor, the City Mayor, the latter having endorsed the same to the Honorable Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, said letter having requested that October 8, 1989 be officially proclaimed as "Lions Service Day" in Ormoc City;
