

RESOLUTION NO. 137

EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE REGIONAL OFFICE OF A RESOLUTION DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES, TACLOBAN CITY, TO TAKE HEED TO THE PETITION OF THE BARANGAY OFFICIALS, PARISH PRIEST, SCHOOL OFFICIALS AND RESIDENTS OF BRGY. IPIL, DRMCC CITY, RELATIVE TO THE CONTINUOUS EXCAVATION AND HAULING OF SAND AND GRAVEL FROM PANALI-AN RIVER, THE DISASTROUS EFFECTS THEREOF, AND, FURTHER REQUESTING FOR IMMEDIATE INVESTIGATION AND OCULAR INSPECTION OF RIVER TO THE EFFECT OF PROBABLY PROHIBITING, IF NOT MINIMIZING, THE GRANT OF COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL PERMITS FOR THE EXCAVATION AND HAULING OF SAND AND GRAVEL THEREAT.

WHEREAS, this august Body is in receipt of a Petition dated September 21, 1989, signed by the Barangay Officials, Parish Priest, School Officials and a good number of residents of Brgy. Ipil, Grmoc City, and the residents of Sitio Panali-an, Brgy. Ipil, registering their vehenent opposition to the continuous taking, excavation and hauling of sand and gravel from the Panali-an River;

WHEREAS, as alleged in their petition, the said taking, excavation and hauling of sand and gravel have caused the enlargement of the banks of the river and have deepened its bed, and, during rainy season, the river erodes the land along its banks, overflows its banks causing damages to property and seriously endangering the lives of residents living near the vicinity;

WHEREAS, although those persons and/or private construction firms engaged in the excavation and hauling of sand and gravel at Panali-an River may have paid the government with the necessary fees and, correspondingly, are issued with commercial or industrial permits for the purpose by the Bureau of Mines, Management Sector of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Inevertheless, the consequential dangers to life and property are so paramount and of extreme importance

so that the issuing entity should prohibit, if not regulate, the granting of these commercial or industrial permits;

WHEREAS, this august Body reasonably takes the cudgels of the plight and safety of the residents of Sitio Panali-an, Brgy. Ipil, for it is one of its prime duties to protect the welfare and interest of the citizens of Brmoc. City;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Benjamin F. Tugonon, Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, duly seconded by Kagawad Rodolfo L. Rivilla, Jr.; be it

RESOLVED, to pass a resolution EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE REGIONAL OFFICE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES, TACLOBAN CITY, TO TAKE HEED TO THE PETITION OF THE BARANGAY OFFICIALS, PARISH PRIEST, SCHOOL OFFICIALS AND RESIDENTS OF BRGY. IPIL, ORMOC CITY, relative to the continuous EXCAVATION AND HAULING OF SAND AND GRAVEL FROM PANALI-AN RIVER, THE DISASTROUS EFFECTS THEREOF, and, FURTHER REQUESTING FOR INNEDIATE INVESTIGATION AND OCULAR INSPECTION OF SAID RIVER to the effect of probably PROHIBITING, IF NOT MINIMIZING, THE GRANT OF CONMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL PERMITS FOR THE EXCAVATION AND HAULING OF SAND AND GRAVEL THEREAT;
