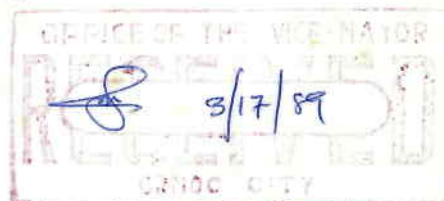

RESOLUTION NO. 38

A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE NATIONAL HOUSING AUTHORITY THROUGH HONORABLE CHAIRMAN RAYMUNDO A. DIZON, JR. TO ASSIST ORMOC CITY IN THE FINANCIAL ASPECT AND DEVELOPMENT OF ITS HOUSING PROGRAM FOR GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES AT PROPOSED SITE IN BARANGAY SAN ISIDRO, ORMOC CITY

WHEREAS, the right to a shelter is one of the three (3) essential needs much dreamed of and longed after for by man, the other two primordial needs being the rights for food and for clothing;

WHEREAS, one good segment in society truly affected by man's housing shortage and problem are the government employees of the Local Government of Ormoc City; whereby, in the current survey conducted by the Office of the City Mayor, out of the 175 regular or permanent employees, there are One Hundred Sixty Two (162) employees who have signified in writing their intention and willingness and are desirous to apply for housing loans;

WHEREAS, the above clamor for simple yet decent and respectable houses to amount to as "future homes" of the government employees in Ormoc City has been deliberated during a conference of the Members of the Special Committee on Housing Program and given with the priority of consideration;

WHEREAS, the National Housing Project of the National Government, with broad spectrum of concern and responsibility in the promotion of the government's project for low cost-housing in a bid to solve the housing shortage which affects millions of Filipinos, has currently launched a "Low-Cost-Mass-Housing Program", a housing project programmed for the homeless Filipinos all over the country;

WHEREAS, based on a newspaper daily that in whole of Region VIII, there are only two places, namely, Western Samar and Eastern Samar which

have supported the low-cost-mass-housing program of the National Housing Authority, and, no place is ever mentioned to represent for the Province of Leyte, thuswise, the MEMBERS of the SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD ng ORMOG, in session, wants to manifest in here a declaration that it fully believes and considers the low-cost-mass-housing program of the National Housing Authority as encouraging and laudable and, is ever desirous to avail of its privileges and benefits;

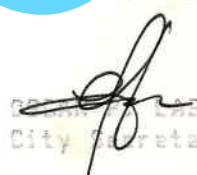

ENACTED, March 15, 1989.

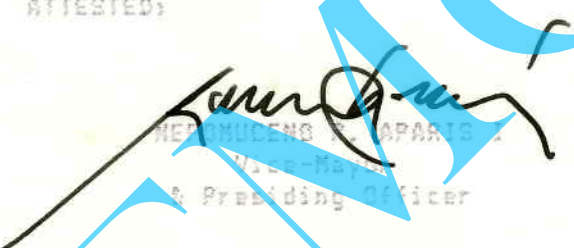
